A) ITEMS INCLUDED IN THE TRAVEL FEE

- Cost of voyage as indicated on the travel itinerary.
- Accommodation onboard (in cabin type stipulated in invoice) and onboard events (except those requiring extra payment).
- Cost of main meals onboard as stipulated in itinerary.
- Hand luggage transportation fees by ship.
- Cost for tour escorts, company staff and Peace Boat staff who will accompany participants during the voyage.

B) ITEMS NOT INCLUDED IN THE TRAVEL FEE

- Any items which are not mentioned in section Care not included in the travel fee. Please find below list of examples of costs which are not covered by the travel fee.
- Optional tour programme fee.
 - Any extra costs that may be incurred by a change in the class of cabin.
 - Costs incurred by procedures deemed necessary for overseas travel (administrative fees for procedures deemed necessary for overseas travel, vaccination fees, visa application fees).
 - Onboard tips for crew members. Additional tipping not required.
 - Port charges - berthing and facility use fees charged by port authorities in each port of call.
 - Travel insurance, telephone bills, bar bills or any other personal expenses incurred.
 - Excess baggage fees.
 - Transportation costs from your home to the port of embarkation and transportation costs from your port of disembarkation to your home, related accommodation fees and luggage transportation fees.
 - Fuel surcharge fee.
 - Visa fee. Visa requirements differ according to nationality. Participants are themselves responsible for obtaining all necessary visas prior to embarkation.
 - International tourist tax.

C) CANCELLATION

Cancellation of the travel contract by the customer. You are able to cancel the travel contract by paying the cancellation fee. Please check the travel terms and conditions of the travel agency where you applied for the cruise for information regarding the cancellation fee that applies to your cancellation.

A travel contract cancellation will also result from a cruise change, class change, or section change.

CANCELLATION FEES (base on per person basis)

- Upon booking - 181 days = MYR500
 - 180 - 151 days = 10% of total selling price
 - 150 - 91 days = 20% of total selling price
 - 90 - 61 days = 30% of total selling price
 - 60 - 31 days = 50% of total selling price
 - 30 - 01 days = 70% of total selling price
 - Same day / no show = 100% of total selling price
- Additional administration fees 5% of the selling price will apply on top of the above charges

D) PLEASE REFER TO THE CRUISE BROCHURE AND THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS PROVIDED BY YOUR TRAVEL AGENCY FOR DETAILS UPON APPLICATION.

- The area shown in the price list includes balcony.
- All cabins are equipped with shower, toilet and refrigerator.
- For single use of classes A1~4 and B, the charge will be 200% of the cruise fare. For classes D1 and D2, it will be 180%.
- Cabin classes A1~4, B and D1 are equipped with electronic bidet toilet seat.
- In classes A1~4, you may specify your cabin. (Once a cabin has been selected, a cancellation fee of 5% of the cruise fare will apply if the booking is cancelled. From 90 days prior to departure, standard cancellation fees will apply.)
- You may be assigned to cabins equipped with bunk beds. We do not accept requests regarding cabin preference on such issue.
- Semi-Single type cabin is a private compartment space created by dividing twin-type cabin with curtain.
- Friendly Outside cabin: Quad sharing; Friendly Inside cabin: 3 persons sharing. (Room service is not available for Friendly type cabins.) The lower berth of a bunk bed reservation in Friendly type cabin is available at an extra cost.
- The facilities of the Semi-Single and Friendly type cabin such as shower, toilet, and lockers etc. are shared among cabin mates.
- Guests with children under the age of 13 (excluding junior high school students) are not eligible for room sharing.
- A preschooler accompanied by an adult can join free of charge. Details are available upon request.
